## The Challenge

Traditional law school curricula focus on training litigators, while over half of real lawyers practice transactional law.

## The Solution

Create a law school curriculum that trains lawyers as both litigators and transactional attorneys.



## Implementing the Solution

1. Identify transactional competencies.
2. Expand the role of transactional subjects in both the core curriculum and elective choices.
3. Implement new teaching methods (supplementing case book teaching):
  - Problem-solving techniques.
  - Drafting.
  - Experiential learning.
4. Develop transactional law clinics.
5. Expand extra-curricular competitions and offerings to include transactional skills and topics.
